I am a supporter of The Springstone School, a non-profit, independent school that is dedicated to providing academic, social, and pre-vocational skills for 6th-12th graders with neurocognitive and Executive Functioning challenges, including Autism. These children have difficulties with organization, learning, coordination, and social skills.

Established in September 2003, Springstone is the first school in the nation to provide services specifically designed for middle school students featuring small, structured classrooms and an integrated teaching approach. With the success students found at Springstone, and the push from school districts and parents, the program has grown into both a middle and community high school. Our students typically do not thrive in the public school system, where they are often isolated, bullied, and misunderstood by both teachers and peers. Springstone's mission is to foster independence, self-advocacy and a sense of community while incorporating Common Core academics in preparation for post high school transitions.

The Springstone School hosts two fundraising events throughout the year to support funding our program. We are preparing to hold our fifth annual Senior Star Service Dinner & Fundraising Gala.
